Subject: ADVISORY COUNCILS AND REPRESENTATIVES

Superintendent Representative:

1. A superintendent representative may attend all regularly scheduled Board meetings and special meetings as a representative for the member superintendents.

Management Advisory Council:

- 2. A Management Advisory Council shall be formed, consisting of the chief financial officer or chief operating officer (or another person with the same level of decision-making authority) from each school district participating in the Rocky Mountain Risk Insurance Group and Rocky Mountain Risk
- 3. The Management Advisory Council shall meet regularly with the Executive Director and shall review and make recommendations regarding Rocky Mountain Risk Insurance Group and Rocky Mountain Risk actions, programs, operations, and activities.
- 4. The Management Advisory Council may elect a representative to attend the regularly scheduled Board meetings and special meetings as a representative of the Management Advisory Council.

Workers' Compensation/Loss Control Advisory Council:

- 5. A Workers' Compensation Loss Control Advisory Council shall be formed, consisting of a representative from each school district that is a member of the Rocky Mountain Risk Insurance Group and Rocky Mountain Risk.
- 6. The Workers' Compensation/Loss Control Advisory Council shall meet regularly with the Executive Director and shall review and make recommendations regarding the Rocky Mountain Risk Insurance Group and Rocky Mountain Risk actions, programs, operations, and activities, including the administration and operations of the self-insurance pool and BOCES.
